JUMPERS

JUMPER CLASSES: In all jumper classes, ties involving first place will be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be broken by the fastest time. Orders will be drawn per USEF JP112. Time allowed to be based on a minimum speed of 382 yards per minute for all jumper divisions. Table II, 2(c) classes - power phase to be timed. * indicates bonus point class. Horses be entered in at least one (1) other class in their respective division at this show to be eligible for a Classic. Grand Prix horses must be entered in at least one (1) 1.30m - 1.45m Jumper Class at this show to be eligible for the Grand Prix. Riders must ride for awards in the Grand Prix and Classics to be awarded the prize money. Horses do not need to show in a class to qualify to show in the Open Jumper Classics. See Rule 34.

COMPETITION OVERVIEW

To be shown over a special course of hunter derby-type jumps featuring tight roll-Back turns and bending lines which ask the riders to answer questions of adjustability, pace and fluidity in their rounds. Two Rounds will be held over two days with scores announced for each round and averaged together for the final score. All riders return for Round 2 in the reverse order of go. The top four riders from Rounds 1 and 2 will work off. Work off courses will be determined by the judges. Work off scores will not be announced. NOTE: For Les Talents Hermes 3'3, the top four riders will swap horses for the work off course determined by judges.

JUDGING

To be judges on the rider's equitation style, technical merit, judgment and execution of an efficient pace and track. Rounds 1 and 2 to be judged under the open numerical scoring system by two judges seated in two separate locations. Each judge shall submit a single score, and the two separate scores will be averaged to produce a final score for each rider for each phase. If a tie for the 4th finalist exists at the completion of Round 2, it will be broken according to the higher combined score in Round 2. If the combined scores in Round 2 does not break the tie, then the higher score from 'Judge A' will break the tie.

ELEGIBILITY/RESTRICTIONS

Les Talents Hermes is open to amateur, junior and pony riders. No cross entries between sections. The same horse must be ridden through all phases of the competition. However, due to illness or injury of the horse, a rider may petition to ride a substitute horse. This substitution must be approved by the Appeals Committee consisting of the Show Manager, the Steward and the Official Veterinarian, who has in fact examined the horse and determined its unsuitability to continue in the competition.

AWARDS FOR EACH SECTION

Awards will be presented following the work off. The top ten competitors must be formally attired and mounted for the awards ceremony.

- Hermes rider show coat for the winner
- Hermes blanket for the winner
- Hermes awards for the 2nd-4th place finishers.
- Custom ribbons for the top 10 finishers

OVERALL GRAND CHAMPION AWARD

The rider with highest combined score from Rounds 1 and 2 as well as his or her trainer will be awarded a pair of VIP tickets to the 10th Annual Saut Hermes horse show March 22-24, 2019. Hosted at the magnificent Grand Palais in the heart of Paris, Saut Hermes brings together the 50 best horses and riders along with twenty promising young riders to compete in this 5-star international show jumping competition. Included is a 4-night stay at the Marriott Champs-Elyees, a 5-star hotel located around the corner from Saut Hermes and a \$2,000 gift card for travel and expenses. Overall Grand Champion will be presented immediately following the awards ceremony for Les Talents Hermes Pony. The winners from all three sections of Les Talents Hermes must be present and formally attired for the Overall Grand Champion presentation.
